

Yokohama Port Corporation's Environmental Policy

We at Yokohama Port Corporation (YPC) have recognized environmental conservation and climate change measures for the realization of a sustainable society to be an important management issue, and have continuously worked on this issue until now. We have now established Yokohama Port Corporation's Environmental Policy.

This policy documents the various approaches we take to further promote these initiatives - including promoting environmentally friendly management, training human resources, adopting new technologies, conversations with diverse stakeholders, and contributing to the construction of green supply chains.

Based on this policy, we contribute to the realization of a sustainable society through active initiatives in dealing with environmental issues.

As a company responsible for the administration and management of the port, we fulfill our responsibilities to the environment and actively strive to work on environmental issues with diverse stakeholders, based on the following policy.

1. Promotion System

Based on a resolution by the Board of Directors, and under the leadership of management, we have set environmental conservation goals and promote the conservation of the environment.

2. Legal Compliance and Governance

We comply with environmental laws, regulations, ordinances, and social norms, as well as our company's own regulations.

3. Measures for Environmental Issues

Through our business activities, we prepare for natural disasters, including adaptations to climate change, and strive to reduce greenhouse gas emissions as well as conserve the natural environment and biodiversity.

In particular, we are focused on promoting the following initiatives.

- ① As part of our preparations for natural disasters, including adaptations to climate change, enhancing our resilience in both tangible and intangible ways.
- ② In addition to thoroughly reducing greenhouse gas emissions and promoting the formation of a Carbon Neutral Port (CNP), we contribute to the construction of green supply chains.
- ③ We work to minimize environmental burden, through striving to conserve natural environments and biodiversity, considerations of thorough safety and the environment in facility management and management operations, actively adopting new technologies and materials, and realizing a circular economy.

4. Educating and motivating employees, Raising Awareness, and Sharing Information

We continuously educate and encourage our employees, raise awareness within our company to ensure that all staff understand and implement our environmental policy. In addition, we provide information to the public on our policy and initiatives through our website and other means.

5. Collaborate with stakeholders with Stakeholders

We promote dialogue and cooperation with users of Yokohama Port, government institutions such as port management, partner companies, and the local community, and work with them to create environmental values. Accordingly, we work hard to actively share information and to spread awareness.

6. Active Improvement and Evaluations

We set environmental goals based on this policy, and make continuous improvements while evaluating and verifying our results every year.

The above policy was approved by our company's executive board on March 15, 2026, and enacted on April 1, 2026.
